### **Commonwealth of Virginia vs Hughs**

The Commonwealth of Virginia, To the sheriff of Prince William County – Greetings: You are hereby commanded to summon Hughs to appear before the Justices of our County Court of Prince William, at the Court-house of the said County, on the first Monday in August next, to answer a presentment of the Grand Jury, made against him in the said court, on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1834 “for unlawful gaming, to wit: Rowlet at the race field near Brentsville in the County of Prince William the same being a place of public resort within six months last past.”

And have then there this writ. Witness, John Williams, Clerk of our said Court at the Court-house aforesaid, this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1834, and in the 58<sup>th</sup> year of our foundation.
