

Historic Name: Byrd-Fisher House

A small, two-story, L-shaped, frame house, this home has a one-story, bracketed porch across the front and another one-story porch on its east side filling in the "L." The weatherboard exterior has double corner boards, a plain frieze, and a molded cornice. The front door, with a two-light overhead, is a fifteen-pane glass door. This house is rare in that it is relatively unchanged and continued to be used as a residence in modern times, even though located on a busy commercial street.
