

Commonwealth vs Geo. W. Cochnower, Jos. B. Reid & W. W. Kincheloe

Prince William County to Wit:

Be it remembered, that on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October 1892, Geo. W. Cochnower, Jos. B. Reid and W. W. Kincheloe personally came before me W. W. Buckley a Justice of the said County and severally and respectfully acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the manner and form following, that is to say, the said Geo. W. Cochnower in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and Jos B. Reid and W. W. Kincheloe in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia if the said Geo. W. Cochnower shall make default in the performance of the underwritten condition.

In condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Geo. W. Cochnower do and shall personally appear on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1892 before the County Court of the said County at the Court House thereof and then and there answer a bill of indictment to be preferred to the grand jury in and for the said county against him the said Geo. W. Cochnower for a felony by him committed in feloniously and unlawfully assault and beat with intent to kill the said ( \_ eyer?) B. Newman and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said court then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
