Coleman Gill of the said county came personally before me G. G. Galleher a Justice of the said county on this 24th day of September 1877 and made complaint on oath that Geo. W. Whitbee did on the 8th day of July 1877 in the said county declare and threaten that he would shoot the said Coleman Gill down in his tracks if he should ever speak to him again by reason whereof he this complainant is afraid and has good cause to fear that the said George W. Whitbee will do him some grievous bodily injury and therefore prays he may be requires to give surety to keep the peace towards him. And the said Coleman Gill also says on oath that he does not make the complaint against the said Geo. W. Whitbee nor require such surety from any hatred malice or ill will but merely for the preservation of his person from injury.
