On the eighth day of February 1868 personally appeared before me A. F. Dunn a Justice of the Peace in and for the county of Prince William, George B. Jones of the said county personally known to me who being duly sworn according to law say: That on or about the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January 1868 I was assaulted by one Lucien N. Fewell of Manassas Va. The said Fewell striking and kicking me in the face in a violent and angry manner to the effusion of my blood that left wounds that were painful and seriously interfering with my business to my loss. He also threatened to skin me and my father. "And all the dammed Yankees about" And from his threats and well known character I have reason to fear that he will assassinate me.
