Jacob Roles complains of Charles G. Cannon in custody &c of a plea of trespass. For that the said Cannon on the (blank) day of (blank) 1836 with force and arms &c to wit at Prince William County aforesaid shot off and discharged a certain gun then and there loaded with gun powder and shot at and against a certain brindle steer the property of the said plaintiff of great value to wit of the value of \$50 and thereby and there with them and their so greatly shot hurt and wounded the said steer that by reason thereof the said steer being of the value aforesaid afterwards to wit on the day and year aforesaid died to wit at Prince William County aforesaid - and other wrongs to said plaintiff the said defendant then and there did against the peace and dignity of the State of Virginia and to the damage of the said plaintiff in the sum of \$500. And also for that the said Cannon on the day and year aforesaid with force and arms &c to wit at the county aforesaid shot off and discharged a certain other gun then and their loaded with gun powder and shot at and against a certain other steer the property of the said plaintiff of great value to wit of the value of (blank) and thereby and therewith then and there so greatly shot hurt and wounded the said steer that by reason thereof the said steer being of the value of ___ to wit on the day and year aforesaid died to wit at Prince William County aforesaid. And other wrongs to the said plaintiff the said defendant then and their did against the peace and dignity of the state of Virginia and to the damage of the said plaintiff in the sum of \$500 and also for that the said defendant on the day and year aforesaid with force and arms &c to wit at Prince William County aforesaid with guns, knives and axes attacked a certain steer the property of said plaintiff of great value to wit of the value of (blank) and thereby and therewith then and there so greatly shot, hurt wounded and maimed the said steer that by reason thereof the said steer being of the value aforesaid. And other wrongs to the said plaintiff the said defendant then and their did against the peace and dignity of the state of Virginia and to the damage of the said plaintiff in the sum of \$500 and therefore he brings suit.
