Clerk's Loose Papers  
30 September 1905

Be it remembered that on this the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 1905, Edward Beach and Edward Tyler, of the said county, personally came before me, W. W. Rice, a justice of the said county, and severally acknowledged themselves, to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Edward Beach the sum of \$50.00, and the said Edward Tyler the sum of \$50.00, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to be levied and for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.

Yet upon this condition, that if the said Edward Beach, shall for the term of twelve months, from the date hereof, be of good behavior towards the said Commonwealth, and all persons therein and especially towards H. W. Reeves of the said county; then this recognizance shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
