

Prince William County, to wit.

Be it remembered that on the 9th day of February 1870, John F. Andrews and Samuel Tyler of the said County came before me Summer Fitts, a justice of the said county and severally and respectively acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in manner and form following, that is to say, the said John F. Andrews in the sum of \$2.00 and Samuel Tyler in the sum of \$2.00 to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia, if the said Samuel Tyler shall make default in performance of the condition underwritten.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Samuel Tyler do and shall personally appear before the County Court of Prince William on the first day of the next term thereof, then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and conceiving a certain misdemeanor by him committed in that he did on the 27th day of 1870 assault and otherwise ill-treat divers persons, viz Henry Brown, William Shanklin and others wherewith the said Samuel Tyler and others stand charged and shall not depart thence without leave of the said court, then the above recognizance shall be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
