Sept 22nd 1870

Joseph Utterback being duly sworn deposed as follows

I left two pairs of shoes in Mr. D. Picketts bar room worth six (6.00) dollars. Having missed them, I went to Mr. Jordan's Store and asked if he had seen such in possession of Lewis Triplett or Frank Champ. He said that he had seen them with the shoes, or some like them which they had offered to exchange for a larger pair. He then pursued and as far as Mr. Robert Lewis and there found the shoes in possession of Frank Champ's mother, who stated that they were left by Lewis Triplett, to keep until he called for them.

I in company with the officer Jas. McDonough, found Lewis Triplett and Frank Champ on the farm of Mr. S. Owens, where we arrested them.

They admitted that they had taken the shoes from Mr. Pickett's bar, Frank claimed that he was drunk when they were taken.
