Historic Name: Hibbs and Giddings Building (9129 Center Street, Manassas)

Date or Period: ca. 1911-1912

Original Use: Commercial

Vicinity: Manassas

Hibbs & Giddings, a clothing store, was founded in 1898 by lifelong friends E. Humphrey Hibbs and Eugene G. Giddings. They moved into this, their third location, in 1912. The building, a two-story structure, was designed by prominent area architect Albert Speiden. This is a dignified, substantial, well-preserved and well-proportioned structure, which serves as an anchor and landmark on a busy corner of downtown Manassas.
