Historic Name: Honeywood Farm

Date or Period: ca. 1470

Original Use: Residence

Vicinity: Groveton

Honeywood Farm is a two-story, stone building with a gabled roof and two, interior stone chimneys. It has two, two-story wings, one on either side. There is an earlier, one story, stone kitchen near the main house. The property also features a large, concrete-block, horse barn; a double-tenant house; a stone smokehouse; two frame barns; and a gambrel-roofed barn. Fighting during the Second Battle of Manassas took place on the grounds of Honeywood Farm.
