

Prince William County to Wit:

Whereas John Wrenn of Haymarket in the said County Taylor, hath personally come before me Robert Hamilton one of the Commonwealth Justices assigned to keep the peace in the said county, and hath taken a corporal oath that he the said John wren is afraid Thomas P. Hooe of Pageland in the said County, Gentleman, will beat, wound, maim or kill him or do him some bodily hurt, and hath therefore prayed a surety of the peace against him the said Thomas P.

Hooe: There are therefore on the behalf and in the name of the Commonwealth to command you, that immediately upon the receipt hereof you bring the said Thomas P. Hooe before me, or some other Justice of the Peace of said County to find surety as well for his personal appearance at the next court to be holden for the said County, as also for his keeping the peace in the mean time towards the citizens of the Commonwealth and chiefly towards the said John Wrenn. Given under my hand and seal at Haymarket in the said County the 30th day of December 1833.
