

In Prince William County Court April 2, 1866

The court proceeded to the examination of William Johnson and Thomas Jennings, white men, who stand charged that, they did, on the 13th day of March 1866 in the County of Prince William, feloniously, take, steal, and carry away one bay mule, four years old, of the value of one hundred and twenty five dollars, of the goods and chattels of one Wesley Reid, and with their assent the examination of the said William Johnson and Thomas Jennings is dispensed with & they are remanded to the Circuit Court of the County for trial, and thereupon the said Johnson and Jennings are remanded to jail.
