"A two-story, L-shaped, frame, weatherboard-clad house, this structure has a tall, square columned porch on its front that fills on the "L." Decorative features include a molded cornice with scrolled brackets, gabled returns, and a Palladian window in the south gable. Interior features include symmetrically molded trim with corner blocks, three mantels, and narrow-board pine trim. This stylish home is an important part of historic Grant Avenue."
