Historic Name: Morris – Shannon House

Date or Period: ca. 1905

Original Use: Residence

Vicinity: Manassas

“A two-story, box-shaped, wooden structure, this house has a metal-covered hip roof pierced by a large, centrally placed dormer. The most distinctive exterior architectural and decorative feature is the front porch. The interior trim is in excellent condition, never having been painted. In 1911 this home was owned by Walter Shannon and was the residence of F. E. Morris. Ruth Lloyd, a long-time resident of this home, cofounded the Prince William County public library system in 1952. “
