Historic Name: Peters House

Date or Period: ca. 1895

Original Use: Residence

Vicinity: Manassas

"A two-story, frame-constructed, weatherboard-clad house, the Peters house has as its most distinguishing architectural feature a bracketed, two-story porch spanning part of the house's front and filling in its "L." The porch is open at the first floor and has a rail with cutout balusters on the second floor. At one time it was a boarding house, and between 1936 and 1969 the house contained apartments. This house is a well-preserved example of the well-constructed, generously proportioned types of urban residences built in Manassas in the 1880s and 1890s.
