We the undersigned residents of Dumfries District depending largely on the Telegraph Road as a means of access to our homes, respectfully ask that a substantial foot bridge be constructed across Quantico Ford in front of the home of the late J. Frank Wheat, said bridge to have cement abutments wherever necessary and to be of sufficient height to prevent its destruction by high water.

For the past two years we have been obliged to cross this ford by means of a board, which has been a great inconvenience, especially to school teachers and pupils during the winter months.
