“North of Bacon Race Church, near the Occoquan, is the SIMPSON PLACE. The story-and-a-half house is now unoccupied, though traces of the once beautiful garden are discernible, as are the remains of 14 farm buildings close by. Unfortunately, the oldest tombstones in the burying ground have inscriptions that cannot be read.
