Complaint for Nuisance against the Hopkins Company & Eastern College

To Honorable J. B. T. Thornton, Judge of the Circuit Court of Prince William County, Virginia

This waste matter, consisting of filth and impure matters of different kinds, is cast out from the sewerage system, causing a pool and is then thrown in to a branch. The undersigned state that this is a public and common nuisance, and that the effects from the same will grow worse with the approach of warm weather.
